



You study Intensive English full-time, with a focus on speaking, listening, reading, writing and grammar. We help you to improve your fluency and accuracy, as well as extend your vocabulary. You usually have a different tutor for mornings and afternoons so you will be able to hear different accents.

Speaking, Listening and Vocabulary Development

Develop and practise intensive listening skills while improving vocabulary knowledge, using authentic material from TV and radio, as well as textbook and internet-based resource material.

Reading, Writing and Vocabulary Development

Improve reading and writing skills using a wide variety of formal and informal reading texts such as magazines, newspapers and the internet. Develop a range of reading skills such as scanning, skimming and reading for detail. Learn how to plan and write with structure and cohesion.

Grammar and Writing

Improve your grammar through writing with a focus on sentence structure and linking sentences. Build paragraphs and write different kinds of texts.

English for Academic Purposes (EAP)

EAP option focuses on future study courses while improving these core skills.



Pathways - Intensive English courses

Intensive English courses are open entry. You will be placed in the appropriate level after sitting our placement test



Short courses

Speak Better English

This course aims to improve your English conversation skills as well as confidence and fluency. The emphasis is on speaking and listening.

Duration: 18 hours

Christchurch: Saturdays, 10am - 1pm

Oamaru: Thursdays, 9.30am - 11.30am

This course is not offered in Timaru.

Individual Learning Programme

In this course, you will work on an individual programme in our Language Self Access Centre in the library, with help from a tutor. You can prepare for exams such as IELTS or OET, or focus on your reading, writing, speaking, listening, vocabulary or grammar.

In weeks 1, 3 and 5 of each course there will be a one-hour group workshop on IELTS preparation.

Duration: 18 hours

Christchurch: Thursdays, 5pm - 8pm

This course is not offered in Timaru or Oamaru.





New Zealand Certificate in English Language (NZCEL)

The New Zealand Certificate in English Language is an NZQA qualification that lasts a lifetime. There are six levels from beginner to advanced. These programmes can be used for further study, for work, or for general English development. They aim to extend your ability in all areas of English communication (speaking, listening, reading and writing), prepare you for further ESOL English or mainstream study, and extend your ability, confidence and comfort in a new country.


The NZCEL is an 18-week course, two blocks of 9 weeks with a two week break in between.

NZCEL can be used to meet English language entry into our mainstream programmes. For further details, refer to the entry criteria of each programme and an equivalence table below. NZCEL is also accepted by the University of Canterbury and Lincoln University.

The following diagram shows various pathways from English language to further academic studies available at Ara. You can start at any point according to your level and our staff will assist you along the way.




